

Marubeni selected as a KENKO-KEIEI Brand enterprise

Marubeni Corporation ("Marubeni") has been selected as a KENKO-KEIEI Brand enterprise by the Japanese Ministry of Economy, Trade and Industry (METI) and the Tokyo Stock Exchange (TSE).

Under the KENKO-KEIEI Brand program METI and TSE select from TSE listed enterprises those outstanding companies that strategically practice KENKO-KEIEI or "healthy management" by making employee health and wellness maintenance a top management priority. This fiscal year marked the start of the program. Of the approximately 1,800 companies listed on the TSE 1st Section, one company was selected from each of the 33 industry types. Marubeni was among the 22 companies selected.



Marubeni has enhanced its internal health management structure (internal medical clinic, occupational health physician, etc.) and is enhancing the health of employees and providing support for them to lead more fulfilling lives through such initiatives as: 1. Conducting regular physical examinations for all employees; 2. Providing specific health guidance to prevent patients with severe illnesses such as lifestyle-related diseases from worsening, and; 3. Conducting cancer screening for young employees.
